The Otsar name continues to be fame,

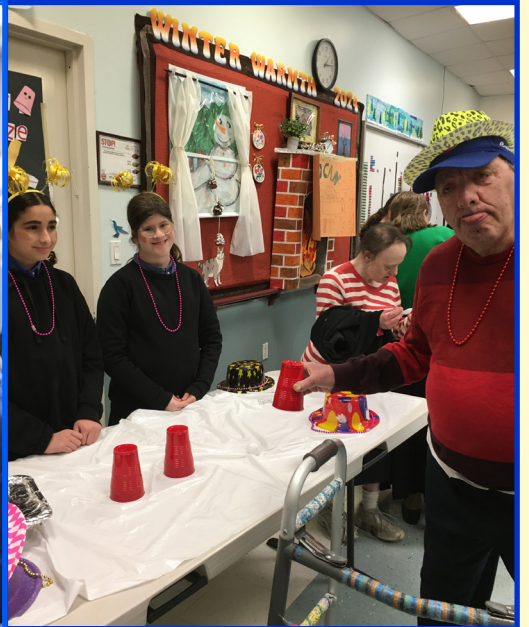
When it comes to doing a mailing,
