This silky-smooth 2-ingredient play dough can be made in just a few minutes with stuff you already have in your house-hair conditioner and constarch!

2 cups cornstarch About 1 cup inexpensive hair conditioner Food coloring (optional)

Cook Mode Prevent your screen from going dark

INSTRUCTIONS

Place the cornstarch in a large bowl.

* Mix in the hair conditioner with your hands-it will just start coming together and it will be pliable and very, very smooth. If desired, add a drop or two or food coloring.

You may need to add more conditioner as you go. Use food coloring to color as desired. Keep covered when not in use.
