## APPLE SAUCE RECIPE

## INGREDIENTS

- 6 medium apples
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup water
- <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup sugar
- 1 pinch salt

## DIRECTIONS

- 1. Cut apples in quarters.
- 2. Peel and core the apples.
- 3. Put apples in a bowl of cold water.
- 4. Cut apples into slices.
- 5. Put them in a saucepan with the water and a tiny pinch of salt.
- 6. Cover and simmer gently till apples are soft.
- 7. Add sugar (depending on how sweet you want the sauce to be).
- 8. Simmer well to melt sugar.
- 9. Cook down sauce.
